

ScoreWrite System® CORONAVIRUS WRITING SAMPLE SERIES

The Coronavirus Writing Sample series is a promotional product meant to be used by therapists conducting Teletherapy or distant learning with their students. The ScoreWrite System® is an effective tool to address handwriting difficulties and provide an easy way to measure progress. The ScoreWrite System Coronavirus Writing Samples are printed on Primary paper, leaving room on the bottom of each page for students to copy the writing prompt printed on the top. The ScoreWrite System® Primary paper is the first in three stages specifically designed to transition a student to writing on the ruled paper typically used in school systems beginning in the second grade. The defined lines of the ScoreWrite System® paper are the exact width of the wide ruled notebook paper. In addition to the typical left hand margin, ScoreWrite System® paper has a right margin line to reduce the crowding of the right side of the paper. The Primary paper provides a dotted line cue for lower case letters and a blue shaded bar that allows room for the descending component of letters g y p q j. This makes it easy to verbally prompt the student to "write only in the white" or "remember to put your tails in the blue". The writing line is visually reduced to a white space with an obvious top and bottom and a horizontal dotted line in the center.

Therapists have permission to email parents a copy of one or more chosen writing samples so they can download and print it in advance of the therapy session. Each writing sample has in its left margin the word and letter count as well as the number of capitals and punctuation marks. These numbers provide the basis for calculating a student's percentage of accuracy for each of the handwriting skill areas scored.
